4. We believe in the deity of Christ, in His virgin birth, in his sinless life, in his miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death, in His bodily resurrection, in his ascension to the right hand of the Father, in His lordship over all of life, and in His personal return in power and glory.
5. We believe in the absolute necessity of regeneration by the Holy Spirit for salvation because of the sinfulness of man, and that men are justified on the single ground of faith in the shed blood of Christ.
6. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; that they are saved unto the resurrection of life, and that they are lost unto the resurrection of damnation.
7. We believe in the spiritual unity of all believers in Christ.
